ORDINANCE NO. 00-1

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION
TO ADOPT A ONE PERCENT SALES TAX
IN THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2000, the City of Santa Clara conducted an election for the purpose of submitting a one percent sales and use tax to the legally qualified voters of the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposition on which the vote was held was as follows:

"A one percent sales and use tax is adopted within the City.

Vote FOR

Vote AGAINST"; and

WHEREAS, seventy votes were cast for and against the proposition; and

WHEREAS, the proposition was approved by sixty-one votes;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the City of Santa Clara, Texas, as follows:

1. The city council hereby declares the results of the election held on January 15, 2000, to be the adoption of a one percent sales and use tax within the City of Santa Clara.
2. The municipal secretary shall send to the state comptroller by United States certified or registered mail a certified copy of this Ordinance along with a map of the municipality clearly showing its boundaries.
