

**ORDINANCE NO 2011- 3**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, TEXAS UNTIL A TIME THAT A NEW NEWSPAPER IS SELECTED. GIVING THE CITY OFFICIALS AND DESIGNEE AUTHORITY TO PUBLISH IN THE NEWSPAPER AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 52.004 Texas Local Government Code provides as soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the governing body of the municipality shall contract, as determined by ordinance or resolution, with a public newspaper of the municipality to be the municipality's official newspaper until another newspaper is selected;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Santa Clara desires to official designate the official public newspaper of the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Santa Clara designates the Seguin Gazette, a public newspaper in and of the City of Seguin, Guadalupe County, Texas, as the official newspaper of the City of Santa Clara, the same to continue as such until another is selected, and shall cause to be published therein all ordinances, notices and other matters required by law or by ordinance to be published.

**Section 2.** The City Officials and/or designee are hereby authorized to publish required matters with the official newspaper of the City of Santa Clara.

**Section 3.** Any and all ordinances, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of Santa Clara, Texas, whether written or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
